**Expand Health Reform Act to Single-Payer Coverage**

Whereas, all major countries of the industrialized world have Universal Health Care for their citizens; and

Whereas, it is not only good policy for the United States to guarantee universal health coverage for all, it also is fulfilling the commitment in the Preamble to the Constitution, to promote the general welfare; therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, that NYSUT support and urge its national affiliates to support efforts to expand the Health Reform Act passed in 2010 to include Single-Payer Universal Health coverage for all Americans.
