2 3	Whereas, there are 10,000 workers on CUNY campuses represented by eight District
4 5	Council 37 locals; and
6 7 8	Whereas, PSC members work side by side with these DC 37 members who work as college assistants, accountants, custodial workers, and other titles; and
9 10 11	Whereas, these DC 37 workers have been working with expired contracts, and no negotiated salary increases, for as least as long as PSC members have; and
12 13 14	Whereas, scores of DC 37 workers participated in the October 1 "Wake Up" rally at Chancellor Milliken's home; and
15 16 17	Whereas, the battle of individual public unions against austerity contracts is becoming increasingly difficult and protracted; and
18 19 20	Whereas, the solidarity and joint actions of public labor unions would strengthen our common cause; therefore be it
21 22 23	Resolved, that as we focus on organizing our own members, the PSC encourage chapters to bring together PSC and DC 37 and other CUNY-based union members to work in common to achieve fair contracts for all.
