## SEEKING LEGISLATION ALLOWING MEDICARE TO NEGOTIATE DRUG PRICES

- 1 WHEREAS, prescription drugs are a major factor in the rising cost of employer provided health
- 2 insurance; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the cost of prescriptions has a major effect on disposable income of seniors and
- 4 therefore on their quality of life; and
- 5 WHEREAS, many seniors are forced to choose between medicine and food, sometimes forcing
- 6 them to skip or reduce dosages resulting in deteriorating health and leading to increased health
- 7 care costs; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the VA already exists as a successful model for negotiating drug prices; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the same drug by the same manufacturer can be purchased for significantly less in
- other countries; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, that NYSUT and its national affiliates, the American Federation of Teachers,
- 12 the National Education Association and the AFL-CIO continue to seek legislation which
- allows Medicare to negotiate drug prices.
